1. Read Exodus 34:8-17
2. What is a covenant? What is the renewal of the covenant with Israel? Why was this necessary?
3. What do we learn about prayer from Moses' prayer in v.9 (think of it in the context of the end of ch.33)?
4. What do we learn about the way salvation works by looking at Moses' role in rebuilding God's relationship with His people?
5. We see here in the renewal of the covenant that this covenant wasn't a one-way street. What was God requiring of Israel?
6. What three practical guidelines does the Lord give to Israel to help them remain faithful to Him in renewing the covenant with them?
7. What are the practical parallels from this passage for us as believers? Why doesn't this have parallels for us as a nation?
8. What does it mean to be unequally yoked? How does this pertain to marriage? How does it pertain to the church? What other realms does this pertain to, and how would you apply it?
9. What practical application does this passage have for you personally?
