

SERMON STUDY QUESTIONS

JANUARY 15, 2017

1. Read Exodus 33:12-23
2. What does this scene in particular, and Exodus in general, tell us about how salvation works?
3. Practically speaking, what does this tell you about how you can be sure God accepts you?
4. What is the gist of Moses' requests here in this face to face conversation with God? What does this tell us about what the goal of the Christian life is – (or to put it another way, why it is that God redeems a people for Himself). Read Revelation 21:1-3.
5. Clearly Moses was not wanting to continue the journey if God wasn't going with them, even though He still promised to bless them. Why is this?
6. Why is it so important to think of your relationship with God *primarily* in terms of life *with* God? How does this shape the way you live the Christian life?
7. What is the danger of thinking of your relationship with God *primarily* in terms of what you do *for* God or what you can get *from* God, rather than as a life *with* God?
8. Practically speaking, what does life *with* God look like?
9. How does this scene point us to Jesus and our total dependence upon Him?
