- 6. How does the Westminster Larger Catechism questions 135 and 136 help us to understand the nature of murder?
- 7. How do we know love and how should our actions reflect that love?
- 8. How do we know that we are of the truth? What if our hearts condemn us?
- 9. What is the command of God and how do we keep it?
- 10. How do we know that we have the Spirit?
