

SERMON STUDY QUESTIONS

SEPTEMBER 9, 2018

1. Read Revelation 22:6-21
2. As we saw, John concludes the book (which is a letter) of Revelation by reasserting the primary themes from the prologue. The first of these themes is the divine inspiration behind this letter. Why is this important to assert?
3. The imminence of the events spoken of in the book of Revelation – that these things “must soon take place” – is something that many futurists struggle to make sense out of. That, together with the fact that a number of things haven’t yet taken place nearly 2000 years later can make the timing of the events of Revelation confusing. How do you reconcile this? And what is the time period that the events of Revelation are pointing to?
4. Practically speaking, why is it important for God’s people to understanding the timing of the events of Revelation? What is the benefit of knowing this?
5. John also reasserts the blessing attached to this book. As we see here this blessing comes from “keeping the words of this prophecy.” What does this mean? Or to put it another way, what is the main point of application this book is trying to impress upon us?
6. John asserts that blessing comes from keeping the words of this prophecy. What does it mean to be blessed? Why, if looking at things from face-value, is it sometimes hard to believe that you’re blessed from keeping these words? Do you believe that blessing comes from keeping these words? Assuming you do, please explain why and in what form these blessings come?
7. What does it mean that Jesus is coming quickly? How does it help you to keep His words knowing that He is coming quickly?
8. What point of application can you make from this text/sermon?
9. How his this study in Revelation impacted you most?
