1. Read Romans 8:35-39
2. What role does the love of God play in the Christmas story?
3. What is the context of this passage, and how does it tie into what Paul has been saying since ch.5?
4. Why does Paul ask if tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, danger, or sword can separate us from the love of God?
5. What does it mean that God's love is unconditional? What are the implications of this as it relates to your eternal security?
6. In v.38-39 the indestructibility of God's love is in view. What are the realms he touches on here to highlight this, and how does this solidify his argument?
7. According to v.39, who is the inseparable love of God reserved for? What does this mean?
8. What are the various grounds upon which the Christian has assurance? Look up Phil.1:6, Titus 1:2, John 10:28, and Eph.1:3-11.
9. What application can you draw from this sermon/text?
