1. Read Matt.5:1-12
2. What is the main point of the Beatitudes, and what are they saying and what aren't they saying?
3. What does it mean to be pure in heart? How do we reconcile the fact that we need to be pure in heart to see God and yet we are not perfectly pure in heart?
4. What does it mean that the pure in heart "shall see God"?
5. How can you know that you are pure in heart and will see God?
6. What is a peacemaker? In a practical sense, how can you be a peacemaker?
7. What does it mean to be persecuted for righteousness sake? What consolation are you given knowing you will be persecuted?
8. When you think about the Beatitudes in general, how do they prepare you for living out the rigors of the Christian life?
9. What practical application can you draw from this text/sermon?
