1. Read John 12:12-16
2. The key to understanding what's going on in this passage lies in understanding the prophecy cited from Zechariah ch.9. What is the context of Zechariah 9, and what is that prophecy saying?
3. What is the Kingdom of God, and what does it mean that the Kingdom of God is at hand?
4. On what grounds was Jesus going about saying, "The Kingdom of God is at hand."?
5. How does Jesus show in the gospels that He is the King and that His Kingdom is now among us?
6. How is the Kingdom of God advanced? When will the Kingdom of God be consummated?
7. What mistake did the multitudes make regarding the role of the Messianic King and what His Kingdom would be like?
8. We learn from this episode here that we need to take Jesus for who He is. Practically speaking, what does that mean for you?
9. What does it mean that you live in a time between the inauguration of the Kingdom (which happened in Jesus' coming), and the consummation of the Kingdom (which will happen at the end of the age)? How does knowing that you live in a time of tension drive you towards God's grace, and towards being more gracious?
