1. Read John 4:1-30
2. What does John mean when he says that Jesus “had” to go through Samaria?
3. Why was Jesus willing to weary Himself in order to meet this woman?
4. How does the story of the woman at the well compare and contrast with what John says about Jesus’ meeting with Nicodemus in chapter 3? What does this tell us about the Gospel?
5. Why was it so unusual for Jesus to be speaking with a Samaritan woman?
6. How is the Samaritan woman a picture of us?
7. How does Jesus’ use physical water and thirst to demonstrate the woman’s (and our) real need?
8. How does Jesus’ treatment of this woman speak to us about who the Gospel is for and how we should think about sharing it with others?
9. How does this passage teach us to think about how the Gospel applies to the racial, and social divisions of our day and what the solutions to them are?
